Refer to the following for hazardous waste disposal:

- The generation, storage and disposal of hazardous wastes can result in significant liabilities and cost to the Institute. All research projects, existing and proposed, should be evaluated for the possible generation of hazardous wastes.
- Only the UTSI Safety Office is authorized to arrange for the removal of hazardous, or even questionable, wastes from the UTSI campus. This includes universal wastes (fluorescent light bulbs and batteries), surplus computers, monitors and other electronic equipment, used oil, old or surplus chemicals, and actual hazardous wastes.
- If you generate a waste product, but are unsure if it is hazardous, please contact the Safety Office, 393-7208 for review.
